S.Y.B.A. (Gandhian Thought)

G2: Social Thought of M.K. Gandhi

[**Objective**: To acquaint the student with various aspects of the social thought of M.K.Gandhi. The first two units will pertain to the social thought in general and next two to his religious thought. Units five and six will pertain to his political thought and the last two units to his economic thought.

The approximate duration of teaching of each unit is 12 lectures]

Part I: Social and Religious thought

- **Unit 1:** (a) Relation between man and society.
 - (b) Concepts of Varna, Caste and Ashrama
 - (c) Concepts of social change and social reconstruction through non-violent means.
- Unit 2: Gandhi's eighteen point constructive programme with special reference to communal harmony, removal of untouchability, role and status of women, Kisan, Labour and Adivasis, Khadi and other village industries, prohibition of liquor, adult education, Economic equality and his message to youth.
- **Unit 3:** (a) Morality and Religion; Faith and Reason
 - (b) Relationship between God, Truth and Ahimsa.
 - (c) Interreligious harmony, fundamental unity of all religions
- **Unit 4:** (a) Views on Hinduism, The approach to idol worship, The concept of Vishnavajana, Interpretation of Dharmashastra and the *Geeta*.
 - (b) His understanding of other religions; the concept of prayer and worship, Approach to conversion.
 - (c) The problem of religious instruction through education.

- Unit 8: (a) Swadeshi and Decentralisation; Small scale industry, Khadi and cottage industry.
 - (d) Dignity of labour, equality of wages, Problem of leisure
 - (e) Trusteeship and Socialism
